Landesrabbiner Dr. I. E. Lichtigfeldmuseum (Synagogue)

On display there are cultural objects, archival materials and fotografic reproductions which call to mind the life of the former Jewish citizens. The collection allows to gain an insight into the religious, social and political circumstances of the Odenwald Jewish community in the past centuries.

Opening hours: From 2nd Saturday before Easter to the 1 November: Sunday to Thursday: 2.30 p.m. - 5.30 p.m.



Nicolaus-Matz-Bibliothek (Church Library)

Established in 1499 when Nicolaus Matz, the canon of Speyer, donated his private collection of 117 books to the town of his birth. Today, the collection contains approximately 44 manuscripts (14 of which stem from medieval times), 157 incunabula until the year 1500 and about 4000 printed publications from the 16th and 17th century. Guided tours must be booked in advance.

Kainsbacher Mühle

The fully operative historical mill was first mentioned in 1426 in Nieder-Kainsbach in Gersprenztal in Odenwald. It is possible to book a guided tour through this technical and historico-cultural monument.


Eulbacher Park
